**ORDER CONSOLIDATING
ADDITIONAL RELATED CASES**

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020, the Court entered an order consolidating all then-existing and “any future related actions, under the docket number of this, first filed case: 1:20-cv-00382-JEJ . . . under the new title ‘*In re Rutter’s Inc. Data Security Breach Litigation*’ (the “Consolidated Action”).” ECF No. 12 (“Consolidation Order”).

WHEREAS, paragraph 6 of the Court’s March 26, 2020 Consolidation Order provides that “this Order shall apply to any action filed in, transferred to, or removed to this Court which relates to the subject matter at issue in this case.” ECF No. 12.

WHEREAS, two additional actions have been filed in this District against Rutter’s Inc. related to the same data breach: (1) *Lavezza v. Rutter’s Holdings, Inc.*, No. 1:20-cv-00482-JEJ (filed March 25, 2020); and (2) *Johnson v. Rutter’s Inc.*, No. 1:20-cv-00516-JEJ (filed March 31, 2020).

WHEREAS THIS MATTER having come before the Court by Plaintiffs' Motion to Consolidate Additional Related Cases and its accompanying Memorandum of Law, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

1. *Lavezza v. Rutter's Holdings, Inc.*, No. 1:20-cv-00482-JEJ and *Johnson v. Rutter's Inc.*, No. 1:20-cv-00516-JEJ are hereby **CONSOLIDATED** with *In re Rutter's Inc. Data Security Breach Litig.*, No. 1:20-cv-00382-JEJ, pursuant to this Court's March 26, 2020 Consolidation Order.
2. The Clerk of Court is directed to close the *Lavezza* and *Johnson* cases and is further directed to transfer all documents already docketed in those cases into the Consolidated Action.
3. Given the likelihood that additional cases may still be filed, in the interests of judicial efficiency, the Clerk of Court is directed to mark as "Related" and to consolidate with this action all future actions that are filed in, transferred to, or removed to this District that relate to the same data breach at issue in this case in accordance with the Court's March 26, 2020 Consolidation Order.
4. Interim Co-Lead Counsel shall assist the Clerk of Clerk with carrying out the Court's March 26, 2020 Order by notifying the Clerk of any additional actions subsequently filed against Rutter's arising out of the same data breach so that those cases may be consolidated with this action.
